FOLSOM AREA DEMOCRATIC CLUB MEETING GUIDELINES RESPECTING EACH OTHER

- 1. Assume everyone's good intent.
- 2. Be kind to others especially those with whom you disagree.
- 3. Discuss the issue, not the person.
- 4. Stay on the topic.
- 5. Actively listen.
- 6. "Traffic Management:"
 - a. Raise hand to speak.
 - b. Be recognized by Chair.
 - c. Do not hold side discussions.

We hope you find this brief list a support so that all members and guests can participate fully and equitably.

ZOOM RULES:

- By joining via Zoom you understand and agree that your hybrid participation in this meeting by Zoom is more limited than in-person participation.
- You bear the risk of not being able to fully participate, including possibly missing votes or being unable to participate in debate if you are dropped from the Zoom line due to internet connectivity issues, audio/video issues, etc, and understand that the meeting will continue in your absence.
- You also understand that your vote might need to be taken differently than the in-person membership (e.g., roll call or other methods in lieu of a ballot vote).
- Lastly, note that <u>you may not record the meeting</u>, <u>you may not share the link with anyone else</u>, <u>and you may not share your screen or play any audio without authorization</u>. Violation of any of these requirements will result in you being removed from the meeting and disallowed to participate by Zoom going forward.
