

Jump Into 2025

- 3. **Folsom Area Good Trouble Team** Pertinent local issues (ex. \$150 campaign contribution limit, voter registration efforts)
- 4. Bookish Club Monthly book club
- 5. **State Action Team** Tracking local state elected officials bills and votes, and actions members can take
- 6. **Federal Action Team** Tracking federal elected officials bills and votes, and actions members can take
- 7. **Federal Dem Majority Team** Voter outreach to other states with critical Congressional special elections in 2025 (postcards, text banks, phonebanks)
- 8. **Anti-Project 2025 Action Team** Tracking critical issues being proposed/implemented by Trump/Republicans

California Assembly District 7 (AD7) Delegate Elections




OH, FOR FACT'S SAKE! Speaking of Kiley

Current membership count: 150 And Counting!


Wow! What a great start to the new year! It's encouraging to see so many of the 2024 members renewing their membership and new members joining up for 2025.
