

Puts the power in the hands of CA voters to approve emergency congressional district maps.


IS FAIR AND PROPORTIONAL


Provides emergency maps go into effect ONLY if Republicans move forward w/their power grab.

These maps expire in 2030.





Percent of voters registered with major political parties






Congressional District 6 Voter Changes


PHONEBANK PROGRAM







Folsom Dem Voters turn out = 86%
Folsom Rep Voter turn out = 87%
Folsom NPP Voter turn out = 73%
Folsom Overall Voter Turn Out = 83%
