

## **Project 2025**

# Creating a Horror Show (and how to Survive) Part I

If you have been online, or watching TV lately, you have probably seen something about the Far Right's Project 2025. You probably know that it's not good for the future of Democracy. But, do you know why?

This stuff is scary, but learning more about it is the first step in fighting back.

Learning everything in one issue would be like trying to watch all of Game of Thrones in one day, so we're breaking it up for you in issues.

#### The Pitch

Project 2025, also known as the 2025 Presidential Transition Project, aims to give unprecedented power to the president, dismantle many government agencies, and strip many of our rights.

Project 2025 aims to place the entire executive branch under the president's exclusive control and reclassify federal civil service workers as "political appointees" hired (and fired) at the whim of the president.

#### Seasons 1-2

Project 2025 Aims to do the following:

#### Season 1 - Climate Change

- Rescind all climate policies from its foreign aid programs
- Repeal the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) and Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)
- End the EPA's Focus on climate change and green subsidies
- Eliminate the Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy
- Withdraw the U.S. from the U.N. Framework Convention on Climate Change and Paris Agreement
- Reduce proposed fuel economy levels

#### Season 2 - Marriage & Families

- Repeal nonstatutory sexual orientation and gender identity nondiscrimination conditions on agency grants for adoption, restricting the ability for LGBTQ+ families and single parents to adopt and foster children
- Affirms that families "comprised of a married mother, father, and their children are the foundation of a well-ordered nation and healthy society
