A few things to get you started...




Voter Registration is still ongoing at Sierra College. Speak to those young voters and get them registered and ready for the next election. Click the button, to the left, to sign up.

Assemblymember Hoover on the Environment

Our State Assemblymember certainly has a strong voting record on environmental issues, but do you know what it is? When Josh Hoover isn't busy sucking up to the Chambers of Commerce, NRA, and Kevin Kiley, he's been hard at work voting against our planet. Here's his voting record over the past legislative session:

- NO on AB 1167 requiring funding for restoration and abandonment when transferring ownership of oil wells
- NO on SB 261 and SB 253 requiring large companies to disclose their climate risk and carbon emissions respectively
- NO on AB 1866 to clean up idle oil & gas wells
- NO on SB 1053 placing restrictions on single-use plastic bags
- NO on AB 347 restricting the use of PFAS substances (also known as "forever chemicals") in "juvenile products", food packaging, and textiles

In addition to his abysmal voting record on environmental issues, Hoover is working to speed climate change by authoring a bill (AB12) that would roll back regulations adopted by the California Air Resources Board that require reduction in the carbon intensity of transportation fuels in the State.



<u>Wow!</u> Our representative sure doesn't seem to be representing us. At least not those of us who like breathing clean air, drinking clean water, and not becoming sick from toxic chemicals in the products we buy.

What can you do?

- 1) Call Hoover's office (916-294-9774) and tell him to start voting for our future.
- 2) Help us elect someone who cares in 2026.
